# **SCHOOL MEALS ORDERING APP**

All Junior parents/carers need to download the School Food United App or register online. Junior School Parents/Carers must use this to order and pay for children's dinners each week (if your child has Free School Meals you must still pre-order their menu on the App each week).

From 9th October, the catering company (SODEXO) will not accept cash. All meals will need to be pre-ordered and paid for on the App in advance. Children who do not have a pre-order will be offered a Baked Potato and Beans. By pre-ordering, you will be ensuring your child gets the meal they want.

Infant parents/carers should also register on the App now so that they are able to pre-order for the winter menu—Infant meals are still free.
