Word	Meaning
autumn	The season between summer and winter
season	Different parts of a year.
tree	A tall plant with a single very thick hard stem or trunk.
leaf	A flat usually green part of a plant, growing out from it's stem, branch or root.
fluttering	Move quickly and irregularly.
deciduous	A tree that loses its leaves in autumn.
hibernate	Stay in a deep sleep all winter
migrate	Move from one area to another.

**FUN FACT:** The pumpkin was first named by the Greeks. They called this edible orange item "pepon," which means "large melon."

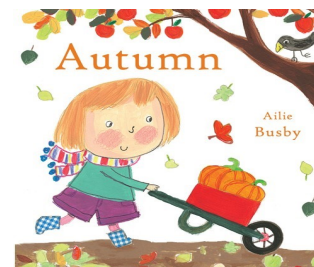
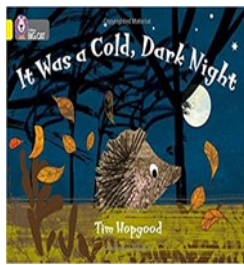
- I know there are 4 seasons in a year.
