## HAPPY BIRTHDAY BLUE COAT!

This year is the three Walsall Blue Coat Schools' 370<sup>th</sup> anniversary. The Blue Coat Foundation has been providing educational provision for Walsall children since 1656!

There will be events and activities this year to mark the extraordinary presence the schools have had in the community for hundreds of years. The anniversary celebrations will be a particular focus of the Blue Coat Sunday Service on March 8<sup>th</sup> and the theme of this year's service and the Blue Coat Exhibition is '*Centuries of Service*'.

The children will be learning about the history of their school and they will have the opportunity to look at historical sources including photographs. Over the next few weeks, the Year 1 and Year 4 classes will be visiting the Walsall Archives at Walsall Library to carry out some research, with Walsall's Archivist, using some of the historical sources stored there.
