Please can **Junior children** bring a £1 donation for the PTA.



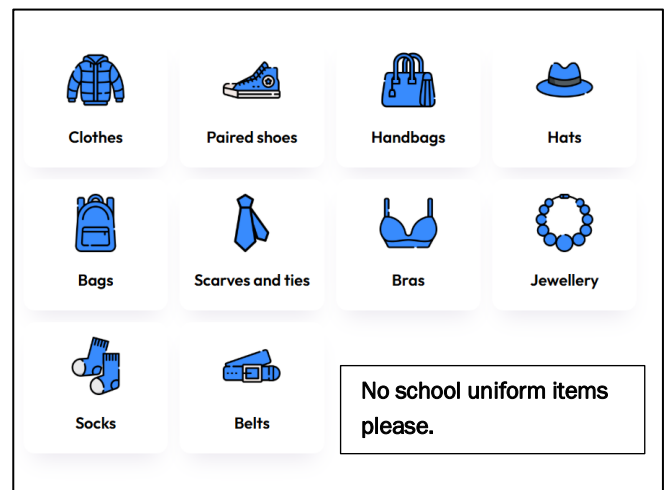
