Of the many hungry dinosaurs.

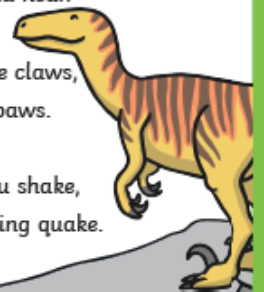
Screech! Screech! Came the sound,

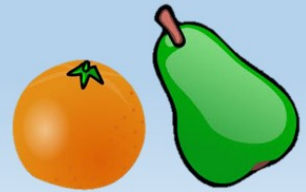

Or maybe a pear.

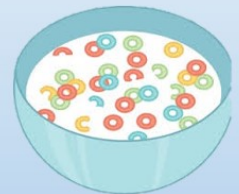
Sometimes it's pasta,

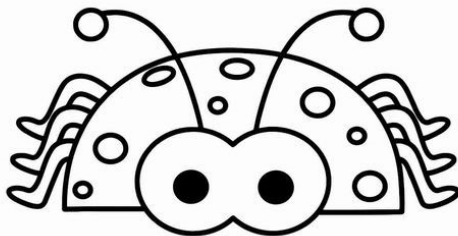

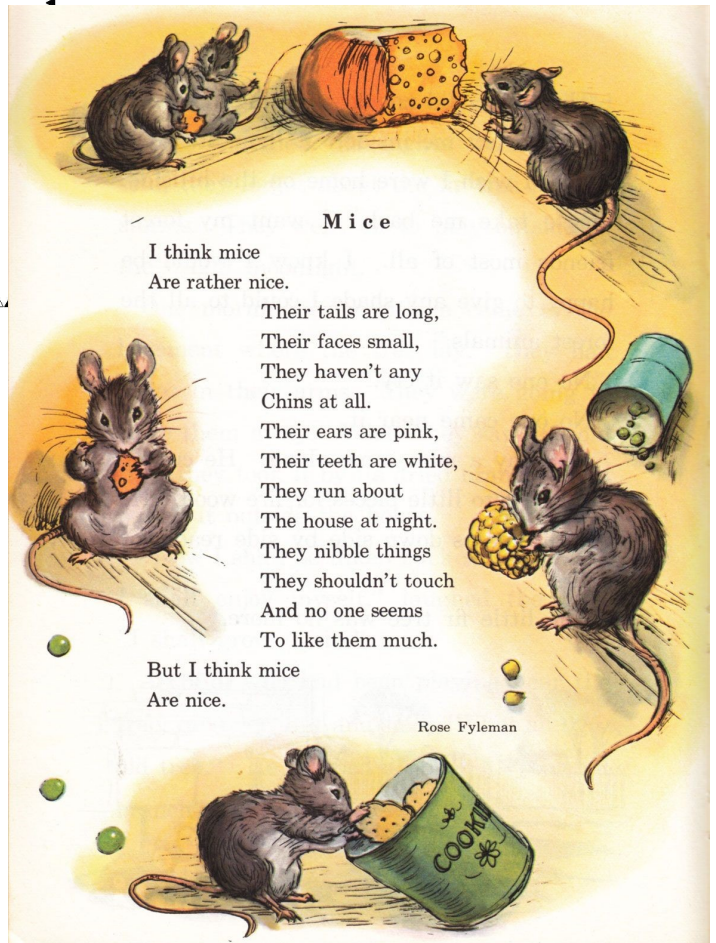
### Mice

Reflecting the sun as I pass.

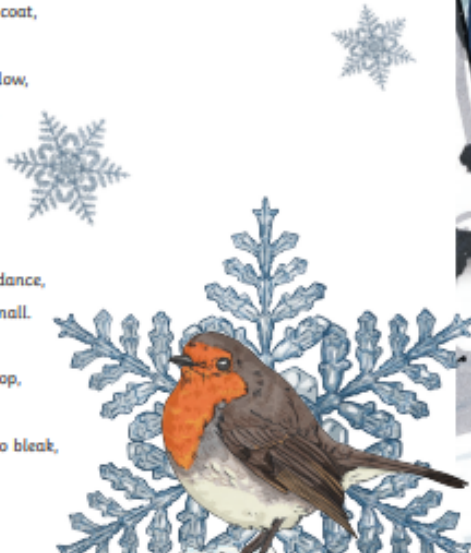
Bushes and plants with a powdery coat,

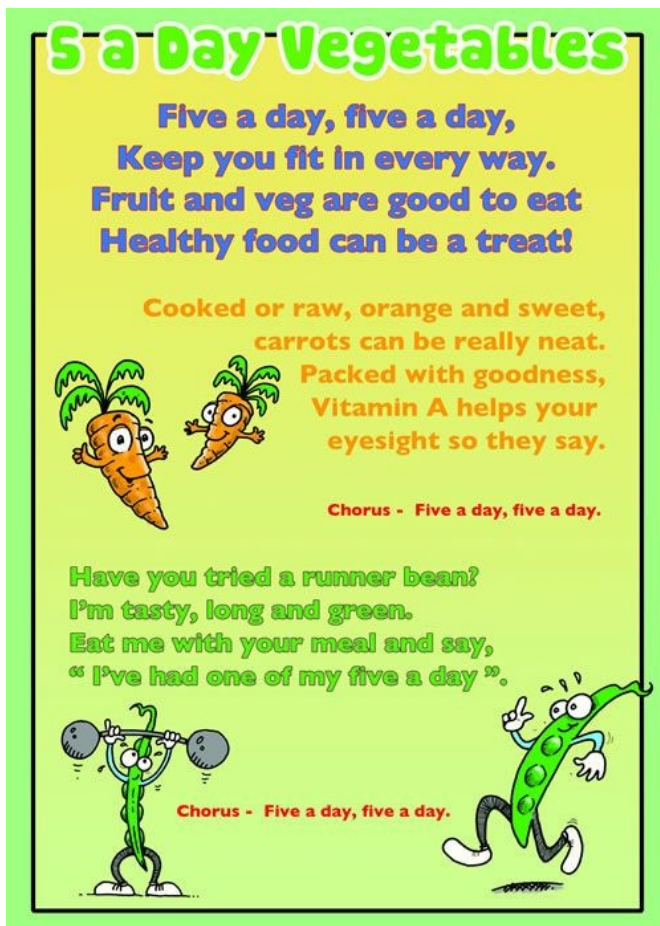

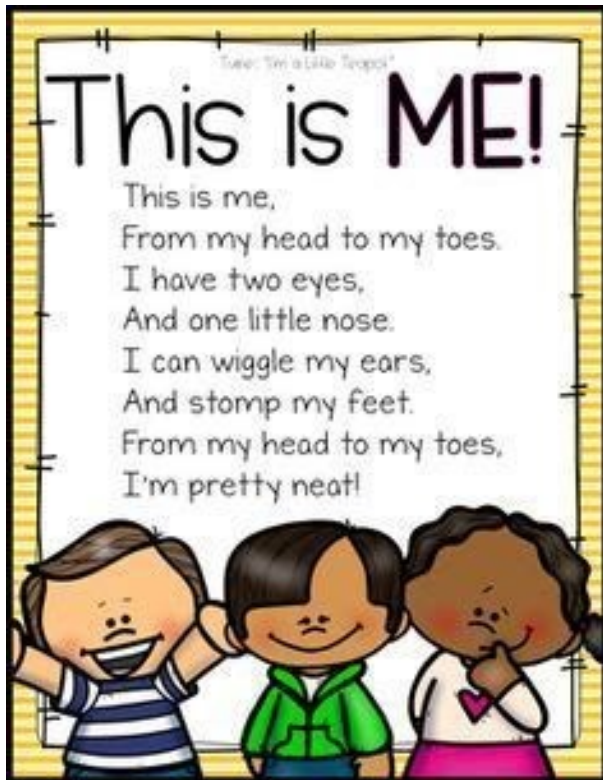


