Junior Parents/Carers, please remember to make sure you have ordered your child's meals for the week on the SFU app by 9.30am on each Monday.

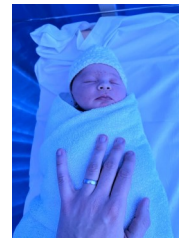
If you have not ordered, your child can only be served a baked potato option.

PROTECTING OUR CHILDREN AND THE COMMUNITY

We have been pleased to learn from Walsall's Health Protection Team that the Blue Community has a particularly high uptake across the Infant and Junior Schools of the MMR vaccine. Over 90% of Blue Coat pupils have had their MMR vaccine ensuring that they are protected from the risks of Measles infection. Because a high number of our pupils have had the vaccine, our whole community is safer.

If your child or someone else in your household has not had the MMR vaccine, there are vaccination clinics available in the Walsall area over the next couple of months:
