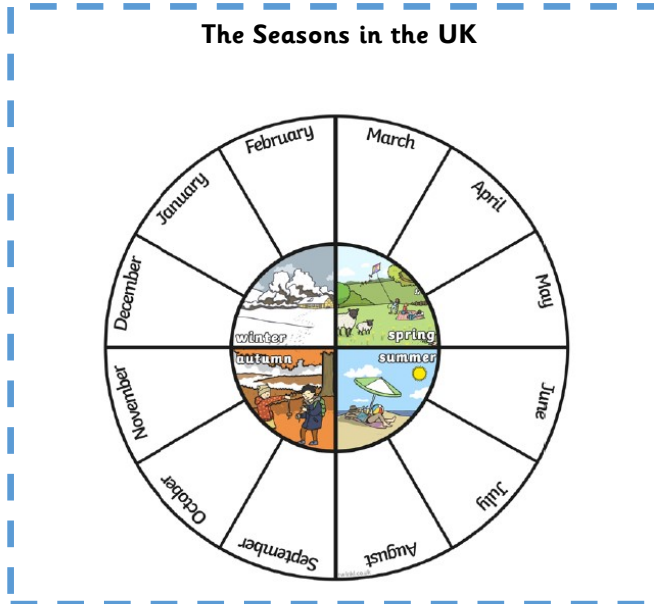


Weather of the World

Word	Meaning
weather	Weather is a physical thing that happens in the Earth's atmosphere.
atmosphere	The gasses that surround the Earth
seasons	The Year is divided into 4 seasons: spring, summer, autumn and winter
temperature	A measure of how hot or cold something is
weather forecast	A prediction of what the weather will be like in the future
symbols	Pictures or signs that help us understand something
record	Keep information about something that has happened
thermometer	An instrument used to measure temperature
observations	What you notice when you look carefully at something
drought	When there is no rainfall for a long time
flooding	When land that is usually dry is covered with a large amount of water
climate	The usual weather of an area



Weather Symbols

sunny	sunny spells	cloudy
thunder and lightning	light rain	heavy rain
sleet	hail	light snow
