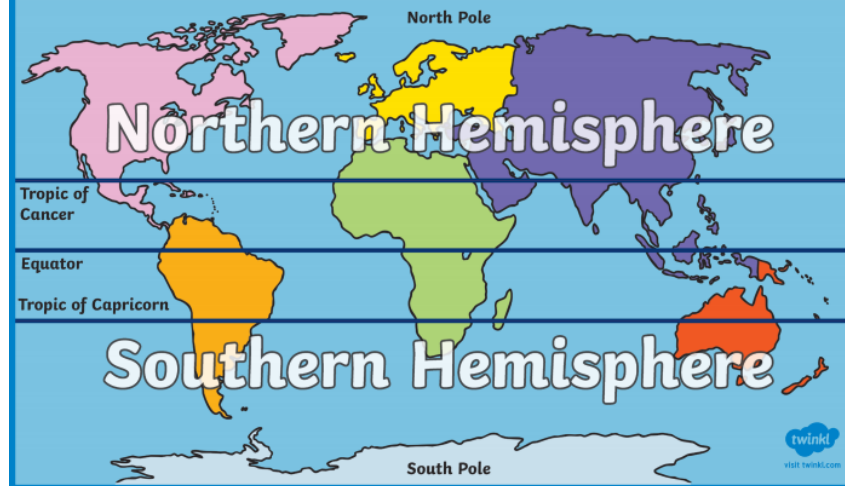


Word	Meaning
weather	Weather is a physical thing that happens in the Earth's atmosphere.
temperature	A measure of how hot or cold something is
climate	The usual weather of an area
Polar	At the North or the South pole
equatorial	Near the equator
Tropical	In the tropics of Cancer and Capricorn
extreme	Beyond what is normal
desert	What you notice when you look carefully at something
vast	Keep information about something that has happened
thrive	An instrument used to measure temperature
Physical features	The natural things that are seen around a place e.g. mountains, rivers
temperate	Mild weather. Neither very hot or very cold.
