





Proud Clouds in the Early Years Foundation Stage.

The children have settled into school and are taking part in lots of activities and learning new skills. We would like you to be part of their learning journey at school too. We are keen to find out any information about your child's achievements at home, such as when:

- they dress themselves independently, or use a knife and fork for the first time.
- they take turns and share with a sibling eg when playing a game.
- they point out letters or numbers they recognise in the environment.
- they can hear all the rhyming words in a story you have read.
- they use the toilet independently for the first time.
- they carefully make a colourful card for a relative.
- they remember to use good manners all the time.
- they make good choices and follow your instructions straight away.

How do I fill in a proud cloud and where do I get extra clouds from?

All we need is a sentence to briefly explain why you are pleased with your child, your signature, and the date. Please write your child's name on the back of the cloud. You can get extra clouds from a box on the windowsill in the main reception, by the office. They will also be on the school website.

What will happen to the proud clouds?

We will stick them in the children's Learning Story Books, and we may also use them for display. We will also use the information to help us plan the next steps in their learning.
