Key Vocabulary

| Word | Meaning |
|--------------------|--|
| rainforest | A dense forest with high levels of rainfall, normally found in tropical areas. |
| layering | Placing one layer of colour over another. |
| inspiration | Feeling of enthusiasm you get from someone or something. |
| composition | The way objects have been arranged in art work. |
| foreground | The part of the view that is nearest to the observer. |
| background | The part of the picture that appears furthest from the viewer. |
| tint | To make a colour lighter by adding white. |
| shade | To make a colour darker by adding shade. |



Henri Rousseau was a famous French painter. He was born in 1844 in Western France.

At school Henri won lots of prizes for drawing.

He is best known for his jungle scenes, such as a **Tiger in Tropical storm (surprised!)**.



Rousseau did not visit the jungle to see the animals, instead he visited the greenhouses in Paris at the Botanical gardens to copy plants.

How do I produce art like Rousseau?

Step 1: Take a pencil and lightly draw the objects in your landscape, e.g. trees, bushes, the horizon and the animals.

Step 2: think carefully about the colours you would like to use— clear blue sky, green for the trees?

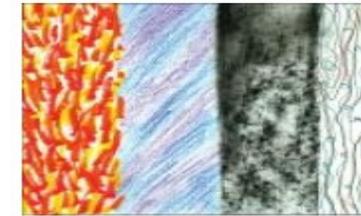
Step 4: Think carefully about which areas are lighter and darker to reflect the light and movement of the animals on your picture.

Step 3— Use different shades and tones to create texture for example when painting leaves on trees.

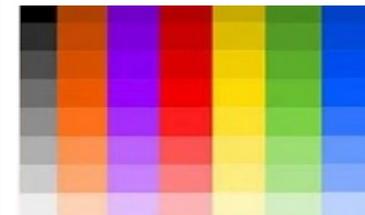
Learning Outcomes

- Create different tones using light and dark.
- They show patterns and textures in their drawing.
- They use a viewfinder to focus on a specific part of a pictures before drawing it.
- Make tints by adding white.
- Make stones by adding black.
- Say how other artists have used colour, pattern and shape.
- create a piece of work in response to another artists work.

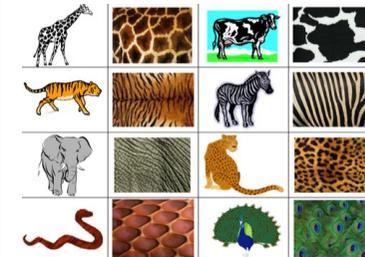
